SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

- Applicant information is kept confidential. It is reviewed only by the Scholarship Committee.
- **Available to eligible children, ages 3 to 17. Adults are not eligible for scholarship benefits.**
- Scholarship awards do not cover full cost of programs - **A minimum 25% contribution is expected.**
- Awards are based on need and residency. *(As Camden taxpayers subsidize the Snow Bowl, Camden residents receive priority.)*
- Scholarships are available to individuals for a maximum of three years.
- All applicants will be notified by email of scholarship awards on a rolling basis, there is no deadline to apply.
- **INCOMPLETE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
